I recently saw Dr. Golbe, who advised me (which I was already aware of) that I continue to show the effects of PSP – primarily in my case, it is most evident in the continuing problems with my eyesight ... both my vertical and horizontal eye movements continue to slow down. He also informed me that the eyesight problem with PSP is the area where they know the least, and so far haven't found anything to successfully deal with the problem. So we will continue to cope with it the best we can.

Now some good news – this past Sunday, Din Bolin, Arno & Margie Thies, and I won our flight in the one-day mixed event at Eldorado! This week, I'm going to Tubac, Arizona to see some of my old Benson High School classmates. (We have been meeting somewhere every December for over 40 years.) Bill Tomson, whom I have now known for over 50 years, is coming to Palm Springs to take me to Arizona. I can no longer travel alone (Toni's rule!).

The Peebler PSP Research Foundation has now gone proactive ... making our first contributions to the Society for PSP of over \$300,000, with \$200,000 earmarked directly for research! Toni and I also attended a PSP Research Symposium in Arlington, Virginia, in mid-November sponsored by the Peebler PSP Research Foundation. I've asked them to send you the handout from the meeting. By the way, for those interested, you may want to put these dates on your calendar. Both of them are directly related to raising funds for PSP research –
