We just returned from a great day at the Moran Eye Clinic in Salt Lake City. There, we met with Dr. Digre, who has seen about one PSP patient a month for a few years. She couldn't stop the PSP progression, but she did teach me a few tricks to deal with my eye sight problems. My eyes, at this time, seem to be the most affected.

The good news is she said "Of all the patients I've seen, you are by far in the best shape! Just keep doing whatever you've been doing – lots of exercise!"

We will return from Europe the end of May, stop in New York so I can see my doctor at Robert Wood Johnson and bring him up to date on my treatments, etc., in Europe. Then we go directly to Hailey, where we rest up for a week before going to Hawaii. Among other things, I will be meeting with Dr. Lam, who is a medical doctor now practicing holistic medicine. We'll be back in Idaho toward the end of June. More later ...
